# Wednesday, May 27, 2020 Is God Good? The Shepherds; Care

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. (I don't lack anything)

- <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.
- <sup>3</sup> He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.
- <sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; **your rod and your staff, they comfort me.**

Psalm 23: 1 – 4 (ESV)

John 10: 10 & 11 (ESV)

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.<sup>11</sup> I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep.

The Shepherds Care...

1. Is compassionate.

Matthew 9: 36 (NLT)

When he saw the crowds, he had **compassion** on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Matthew 20: 26 (NLT)

For even the Son of Man came not to be served but **to serve others** and to give his life as a ransom for many

2. He leads me in the right direction...

Psalm 23: 3 (ESV)

He leads me in paths of Righteousness...

John 10: 4 (NLT)

After he has gathered his own flock, **he walks ahead of them**, and they follow him because they know his voice.

#### 3. When I wander, He brings me back.

#### **Matthew 18: 12 (NLT)**

If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them wanders away, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others on the hills and go out to search for the one that is lost?

Luke 19: 10 (NLT)

For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.

## Psalm 119: 67 & 68 (NLT)

I used to wander off until you disciplined me; but now I closely follow your word.

68 You are good and do only good; teach me your decrees.

#### 4. He Rescues & Recovers.

### Matthew 12: 11 & 12 (NLT)

...If you had a sheep that fell into a well on the Sabbath, wouldn't you work to pull it out? Of course you would. <sup>12</sup> And how much more valuable is a person than a sheep!

#### Psalm 71: 20 (NLT)

You have allowed me to suffer much hardship, but you will restore me to life again and lift me up from the depths of the earth.

#### 5. He sustains me.

### John 10: 27 - 30 (NLT)

My sheep listen to my voice; know them, and they follow me. <sup>28</sup> I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me, <sup>29</sup> for my Father has given them to me, and he is more powerful than anyone else. No one can snatch them from the Father's hand. <sup>30</sup> The Father and I are one."

#### 2 Peter 1: 3 (NLT)

By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence.
